- Execute the fundamental cutting and finishing of the components, specifically by eliminating the surplus aluminum from the casting.
- Conduct a visual inspection of the components to oversee the casting process.
- Identify malfunctions
- Organize your workstation.
- Document information pertaining to work orders and production reports.
- Comply with the organization's health and safety regulations.
